- 100% payback of all entry money. Top 5 places paid.
- Scoring determined by total weight of five salmon and/or trout.
- Entry fee is \$100 per boat.
- Registration must be paid before you leave the dock.
- All captains must be a member of the Hoosier Coho Club and be a minimum of 18 years of age.
- Maximum number of rods fishing at any time is nine (9).
- One crew member and fish must be in line for weigh in no later than 3:00 p.m. (MI City Pavilion).
- Pre-register by submitting form and entry fee to any HCC board member prior to May 3.
- Start time is 6:00 a.m Friday Morning. The tournament committee will use Channel 78 to start and end the fishing period. No lines in the water until the start is announced. All participants must monitor Channel 78 at all times. You must not depart a one-half mile radius from the pier heads until the announcement of the start of the fishing period.
